The Department of Communication Disorders and Sciences at Eastern Illinois University seeks applications for a full-time, 9-month, tenure track faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor, beginning August 16, 2020. Summer employment is possible. Duties include teaching courses at the graduate and undergraduate level, participation in research/creative activity, and service. Preferred area of expertise in adult acquired disorders or childhood developmental disorders. Other areas of expertise considered. ASHA certification and IL state licensure for clinical supervision will be considered an asset.

Qualifications:

Preferred qualifications include PhD in Speech-Language Pathology or a related field (ABD or Master's Degree in Speech-Language Pathology plus additional graduate study beyond the master's degree considered); CCC-SLP, eligibility for Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation Speech-Language Pathology license; and experience in teaching and/or clinical supervision. Demonstrated commitment to diversity and experience with promoting inclusive excellence is required.

Review of completed applications will begin December 1, 2019, and continue until the position is filled. A complete application includes a letter of application addressing strengths and experience relative to the qualifications and responsibilities of the position; a current Curriculum Vita; unofficial transcripts; and the names and contact information of three professional references who can comment on relevant clinical and/or academic teaching experience.
